

## Oil Painting Supply List - Diane Tomash Workshop

--Stretched Canvas, 8x10, or 9x12, or 11x14, or 14x18, maximum a size you are comfortable working on

AND a Canvas Panel for Color Mixing Practice (or two) 8x10, 9x12, 11x14  
See what is available

--Paint Colors

Titanium White OR Permalba White

Ultramarine Blue OR Cobalt Blue

Manganese OR Cerulean Blue

Lemon Yellow, OR Cadmium Yellow Light

Cadmium Red Light OR Vermilion red

Alizarin Crimson

Yellow Ochre OR Raw Sienna

Burnt Sienna OR Raw Umber

If you are new to this, you may want to start out with small tubes. Get at least a 37ml White. You may choose to work with WATER Soluble Oil Paint.

A Basic starter kit usually is a good way to go, if you are a beginner.

If you go this route, do buy at least a small tube or Cerulean or manganese blue as kits

Usually do not include one of these blues

Make Sure You Are Buying OIL Paint, these days, with so many choices, often the help is uncertain. TAKE YOUR TIME. It will serve you well in the long run.

--Brushes: Look for True BRISTOL Brushes

Flats #2, #4, #8, #10 a variety of sizes

Round Brush, for signing and detail, #1 OR #2 sable

--Palette: Disposable OK, prefer parchment, OR piece of glass masking tape sides

For safety, back it with cardboard or Kraft paper

If you are a beginner, good cardboard with the dull side of aluminum

foil taped to it can serve you well as a palette (Better than paper palette)

--Palette or Mixing Knife

--Turpenoid, a small bottle

--Linseed Oil a small bottle, regular OR Cold Pressed, NOT sun thickened

--Paint Cups: two small metal ones or two small jars work well (jelly, baby food)

Metal tops from jelly jars work really well.

--Small Rags, cotton or terrycloth are good, paper towels are OK

--Optional, Apron, smock, disposable gloves or small hand lotion

--Box, could be clean pizza box to transport wet painting home

--Or old towel, plastic to protect car seat
